Aims	Training a new generation of sports managers with the right knowledge and skills to work professionally in any economic environment. The MSA students will learn how to effectively manage sports venues, clubs, financial and information flows in sport, and how to build appropriate marketing strategies. They will also be trained in the legal aspects of sports and research methodology.
Candidates	The MSA course is designed for individuals who have higher education qualifications, leadership qualities and an ambition to develop their professional expertise and make an outstanding career in sport administration.

Programme focuses	<ul> <li>Students study both general and sport specific management subjects including the international business environment, sport diplomacy, economic theory, strategic management, marketing, finance and legal regulation within the sports industry. They also learn how political institutions work in the sports sector.</li> <li>Professional management skills are polished and developed through studying sport logistics, project management, risk management, event organisation, negotiating techniques, and other subjects.</li> </ul>
Culmination	The programme culminates in a graduate qualification paper (thesis).

Programme duration	39 weeks (3 semesters) from September 2019 through June 2020.
